

	Definitions	As an attendee, why do you need the instruction?	As the trainer, what are you aiming to offer?
Basic	<p>Teaches fundamentals of the topic. Suitable for attendees who:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>do not know anything of this subject and only require an understanding OR</li> <li>do not have any of these skills and require basic ability.</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I don't know anything</li> <li>I never received any training</li> <li>I need to understand the principles</li> <li>I only need to do the basic operations</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I will introduce the subject assuming zero knowledge or zero ability from attendees</li> <li>I am intending that attendees will get a basic understanding</li> <li>I will teach them how to do the basic operations</li> </ul>
Intermediate	<p>Appropriate for those who either have a core knowledge of the topic or possess basic skills and want to expand this but are not aiming to know as much as experts or practice as experts and will not be expected in work to make decisions which rely on expertise on this subject.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I already know the essentials and want to improve</li> <li>This is not my main line of work but I want to improve</li> <li>I am not expecting to practice as an expert but I want/need more than the basics</li> </ul>	<p>I will assume that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attendees have understood the principles/ have a working knowledge/want to build on what they know</li> <li>I will not teach them to go back to work to make sophisticated or far reaching decisions based on what they learn</li> </ol>
Advanced	<p>Appropriate for those who seek to specialize in the area or are current specialists of the area and seek updates/interact with peers/</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I am a specialist and I want to broaden my expertise/interact with peer experts</li> <li>I am seeking to become an expert</li> </ul>	<p>I will assume that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attendees have already good understanding and/or good skills in the subject or related subjects</li> <li>Attendees will be willing and/or capable of understanding specialists speak</li> <li>Attendees believe that they need discuss at a specialist level and be challenged by other experts of the subject</li> </ol>
