Prolonged Exposure Therapy for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD)

The presentation will cover the diagnostic criteria for Post-traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), followed by a review of the literature on Evidence-Based Psychotherapies (EBPs), including Prolonged Exposure (PE) and Cognitive Processing Therapy (CPT). The PE protocol will be covered in some depth followed by data supporting the use of EBPs in a group format
